


Purpose built boarding houses provide comfortable, homely accommodation.

Students learn the basics of equipment, breathing techniques, and underwater communication. Kayak skills involve safety, paddle techniques and manouvers. The controlled environment of a pool allows beginners to build confidence and develop essential skills without the challenges of open water. It's a unique, hands-on experience that promotes teamwork, trust, and focus. For many teens, it's a thrilling first taste of a potential lifelong hobby or career.

Moors Valley Country Park is a vibrant forest-based destination that's perfect for energetic, nature-loving teens. With miles of scenic walking and cycling trails, a one-mile wooden Play Trail featuring giant sculptural installations—think ant nests, snake pits, and a "hawk" structure—plus an immersive Tree-Top Walkway, it sparks creativity and adventure.

We'll create a hanging sculpture using fabrics, papers, photos, and small objects from our home countries. Each piece represents a personal memory, tradition, or cultural symbol. When assembled, the artwork becomes a colourful, textured map of global identity—celebrating diversity, connection, and the shared journey of living and learning in the UK
