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INTRODUCTION

1. The purpose of a policy on school uniform is to provide, for parents and students, a clear and common understanding of what is required in the wearing of a school uniform. In general, we wish to encourage students to be clean, tidy and dressed in a manner that is appropriate to the Clayesmore school environment.
2. 'Sunday Best' uniform is worn on special occasions. Parents will be informed beforehand when Sunday Best is to be worn.
3. This policy applies to all pupils at Clayesmore School, with separate sections for Years R-2, Years 3-8, Years 9-11 and the Sixth Form. The appendices to this policy contain the official uniform lists from the online uniform supplier.
4. The policy will be applied within the parameters of the [Equality Act 2010](#).

UNIFORM FOR YEARS R - 2

Daily Dress

5. Pupils should wear their v-neck jumpers with a blue shirt and grey trousers/shorts or tartan pinafore from our online uniform supplier. Navy/black tights or navy socks will be worn with pinafores and grey socks with trousers/shorts.
6. Shoes should be flat, polishable, black leather.
7. Pupils should also have a navy school coat to wear over their uniform in wet weather.

UNIFORM FOR YEARS 3 - 8

'Sunday Best'

8. A navy crested jacket and an optional grey v-neck jumper, with a blue shirt, in a choice of 2 designs. The school tie will be worn with the buttoned collar shirt, but not with the revere collar. Grey trousers are worn with grey socks and the tartan skirts will be worn with navy/black tights or navy socks. Skirts and trousers are available from our online uniform supplier.

Daily Dress

9. Pupils should wear their v-neck jumpers with a blue shirt and grey trousers or tartan skirt from our online uniform supplier. Navy/black tights or navy socks will be worn with skirts and grey socks with trousers. Skirts must be worn below the knee.

10. Shoes should be flat, polishable, black leather and appropriate to wear with both Sunday Best and Daily Dress school uniforms.
11. Pupils should also have a navy crested school coat to wear over their uniform in wet weather.
12. Scarves must be plain black or navy blue, and not oversized.

Jewellery, Makeup and Hair

13. No jewellery at all is to be worn during any games or PE sessions.
14. During school hours, a maximum of one earring in each ear may be worn on the lobe. Earrings must be small gold, silver or diamond studs. No other piercings are permitted.
15. Necklaces are only permitted for religious reasons and with permission from the Assistant Head (Prep).
16. Makeup and nail polish may not be worn with school uniform.
17. Hair should always be kept clean and tidy and if it is on or below the shoulders must be neatly tied back. Hair must be a natural colour and of a style and cut that is not extreme and does not draw attention to the wearer. Pupils must not cut or colour their hair in school.

UNIFORM FOR YEARS 9 - 11

'Sunday Best'

18. A navy crested jacket and an optional navy v-neck jumper, with a blue shirt, in a choice of 2 designs. The school tie will be worn with the buttoned collar shirt, but not with the revere collar. Grey trousers are worn with grey socks and the tartan skirts will be worn with navy/black tights. Skirts and trousers are available from our online uniform supplier.

Daily Dress

19. Students may wear their formal navy crested jacket or they may wear their v-neck jumper with a blue shirt and grey trousers or tartan skirt from our online uniform supplier. Navy/black tights will be worn with skirts and grey socks with trousers. Skirts must be worn below the knee.
20. Shoes should be flat, polishable, black leather and appropriate to wear with both Sunday Best and Daily Dress school uniforms.
21. Students should also have a navy crested school coat to wear over their uniform in wet weather.

Jewellery, Makeup and Hair

22. All jewellery should be discreet and suitable for day-time wear.

Piercings: No facial, tongue or tragus piercings are allowed. Ears: Earrings must be small hoops or small gold, silver or diamond studs. These may be

distributed anywhere around the edge of the ear (top or lobe).

No jewellery at all is to be worn during any games or PE sessions.

23. Makeup should be discreet and suitable for day-time wear and nail polish of a natural colour may be worn with school uniform.
24. Hair must be of a natural colour and of a style and cut that is approved by House Staff (essentially, it should not be extreme nor draw attention to the wearer). Pupils must not cut or colour their hair in school. Hair should always be kept clean and tidy. Permission to grow a beard should be sought from the Deputy Heads and may be granted in some circumstances.

SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE

25. The Sixth Form Dress Code gives senior pupils some freedom of choice. An understated, formal look is what is sought when in Sunday Best, and a look of comfortable formality at other times.

'Sunday Best' Suit

26. From our online uniform supplier: a navy suit with either trousers or a knee-length skirt and an optional navy v-neck jumper. All students will need a formal white business shirt in a choice of button collar or reverse collar. The school tie will be worn with the buttoned collar shirt, but not with the reverse collar.
27. Heads of School and Prefects may wear an appropriate suit from an alternative supplier but their appearance should be formal. They may also wear a formal, matching waistcoat.

Daily Dress

28. Students may wear their formal school suit or they may wear plain, tailored/ smart trousers, which may be chinos, or a knee-length skirt. Trousers/ skirts may be purchased at any high street retailer as long as they are plain, unembellished and have structure (no 'body con' or lycra mix fabrics, no satin or velvet).
29. These should be worn with either a matching suit jacket or a plain fitted jumper and a plain, subtle checked or striped collared shirt. Polo shirts may not be worn.
30. Skirts must be worn on or below the knee.
31. Smart waistcoats/ gilets may be worn.
32. Shoes should be appropriate to wear with the formal business style suits outlined above. Heels should be low or mid-height.
33. Students should also have a formal, plain dark coloured winter waterproof coat

to wear over their suits in cold or wet weather.

Jewellery, Makeup and Hair

34. All jewellery should be discreet and suitable for day-time wear.
Piercings: No facial, tongue or tragus piercings are allowed. Ears: earrings must be small hoops or small gold, silver or diamond studs. These may be distributed anywhere around the edge of the ear (top or lobe). No jewellery at all is to be worn during any games or PE sessions.
35. Makeup should be discreet and nail polish must be in natural, subtle colours.
36. Hair must be of a natural colour and of a style and cut that is approved by House Staff (essentially, it should not be extreme nor draw attention to the wearer). Pupils must not cut or colour their hair in school. Hair should always be kept clean and tidy.
37. Permission to grow a beard should be sought from the Deputy Heads and may be granted in some circumstances.

TRAINING SHOES

38. Trainers must never be worn with school uniform. However, in recognition of current norms in school shoe style, Nike Air Force 1 trainers, in the all-black colourway only, may be worn as school shoes in Years 9-13. They may not be worn as sports trainers for PE or games.
